Below are definitions of some of the terms most commonly-used to describe holograms and related technologies, their properties and production processes.

2D - a holographic image style that places a two-dimensional plane of graphics at, in front of, or behind the image plane of the hologram.

**2D/3D** – a holographic image style created by a series of two-dimensional planes of artwork that are layered into the image volume of the hologram.

3D - a holographic image style that captures a three-dimensional object or scene.

#### A

Achromatic – an optical system free from dispersion or used to describe a colourless (grey tone monochrome) holographic image.

**Augmented Reality (AR)** – a technology that superimposes a computer-generated image onto a user's actual view of the real world. AR devices often use the term 'hologram' to describe the heightened visual reality they provide.

Beamsplitter - an optical device that divides a beam of light into two beams.

**Blazed grating** – a diffraction grating which has a sawtooth profile structure.

**Bragg diffraction** – the diffractive principle which a layered stack of parallel reflecting surfaces of alternate higher and lower refractive index will reflect a beam of light, if and only when the reflected wavefronts are of an appropriate wavelength and orientation to produce






## 2022 Budget

Following on from the Covid 19 challenges of last year, 2021 has not been the Covid free period we had hoped for. However as reported at the last AGM, the IHMA had collated significant feedback from members on what their needs from an Association were and identified areas of change and growth that would increase the value of IHMA membership.

So, despite covid, during this last year, the board has worked to implement some of these changes and additions, and Serge described some of these in his report earlier. Certainly, the re-structuring and interactive additions to the website, offers new and better access to information. Also broadening the IHMA horizons through potential alliances with other related Associations and Institutions, offers further change and growth in the coming months and years ahead.

A significant success so far and worth an additional mention, has been the changes to the Hologram Image Register following feedback from members. The first step was to improving speed and ease of the registration process, and this has certainly played a part in the large increase in hologram registrations in the last year, again something that Serge referred to earlier.

We also recently announced further changes to improve the registration process time through an auto acceptance of customer authorisation to use their copyrighted artwork in Designs submitted for search. This has now been launched and we will look forwarded to monitoring the response.

We can also report this year on a very good and successful on-line conference again and look to build on this success at next Conference.

I also want to thank Jo Ogden who has stepped down from the board this year and we will miss Jo and the real value she brought to the board. But the loss of Jo is mirrored by the gain of the new board member and welcome back Mark Deakes, who will bring his own experience and knowledge to our meetings. Thank you again to both.

The board remain committed to improving and enhancing membership value and have already outlined some of the new areas we will pursue this coming year and look forward to reporting on these new changes at the next AGM
